Donor Recognition Wall

Gifts totaling \$25,000 or more may be identified on a donor recognition installation at the renovated entry to Roberson Museum. Donations will be represented relative to amount and recognition may be made in the name of an individual, family, business, or foundation. Gifts may also be made in memory or honor of another person or family.

Museum Seating

Donors who contribute at least \$50,000 will be recognized on the donor wall and on new museum seating that will be made available throughout the institution.
